We give thanks to God that there were no injuries. Repairs will need to be made so that the girls can once again utilize that dormitory. The whole electrical installation system in all buildings must also be improved as it has been established by authorities that faulty wiring was the cause of the fire.

David Woods Bartley has seen his fair share of successes and setbacks, from directing a nationally recognized nonprofit to battling a life-threatening mental illness. The latter, a tough fight with clinical depression, led David to a suicide attempt. Thanks to the support of a great many people David continues the important yet still challenging journey from the isolation of mental "hellness" to the inclusive space of metal wellness.

In addition to giving two TED talks and being names a 2021 Mental Health champion by the Steinberg Institute, David has presented more than 500 times to audiences across the United States, Canada, Central America, and India, giving in-person and virtual presentations on the subjects of mental health, suicide awareness and prevention, organizational culture, and leadership.
